



2nd ANNUAL MAD ALPINE WJR RACE SATURDAY, JANUARY 5, 2018 Giant Slalom

Mad Alpine looks forward to hosting WJR at our home ski hill, Tyrol Basin!

Location & Parking:

Tyrol Basin is located just 5 miles north of Mount Horeb, Wisconsin and a quick 20 minutes west of Madison. For those planning to come up Friday night you will find a lot of lodging options between Mt. Horeb, Verona, and Madison.

Parking attendants will be on staff Saturday morning to help direct traffic.

Lift Tickets:

Lift tickets are \$31.00 per day including tax for WJR racers and attendees. Sales begin at 8:00AM on Saturday at the ticket window. Payments can be made by cash, credit card or check to Tyrol Basin. A valid lift ticket is required and must be worn to access all chair lifts.

Waiver:

A competition waiver is required for all athletes. Please fill out the waiver and bring with you to the ticket window Saturday morning.

Boot/Equipment Changing Area:

Tyrol's main chalet is available for use but space is limited. In addition, we have a tent available exclusively for WJR athletes and parents to get ready in and to store gear. The tent will be located near the bottom of the race trails.

Food and Beverages:

Food and beverages will be available for purchase in the Chalet. Tyrol will also have a food stand set up near the finish area with burgers/brats and other snacks for purchase (cash only please).



Schedule:

We will be staggering the first run start time by 30 minutes with U8-U12 starting first, followed by U14-U20 athletes.
